The initiative is designed for expansion throughout Jamaica, the Caribbean, the United States, Africa, and global diaspora communities.



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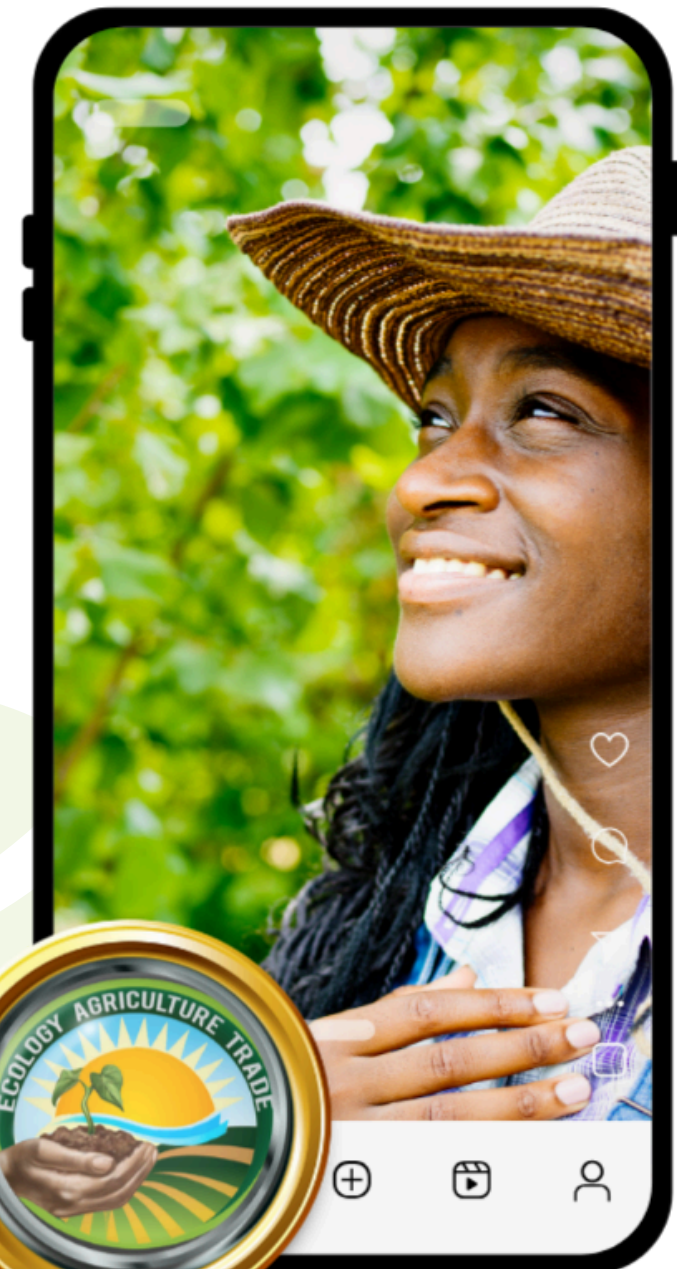
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Digital Infrastructure & Marketplace Expansion

E.A.T. is currently completing development of the E.A.T. mobile application and expanding [MyEcoHive.com](https://www.myecohive.com), an international marketplace and digital networking platform focused on:

- Wellness services and education
- Sustainable tourism experiences
- Community trade opportunities
- Farmer and artisan promotion
- Green technology and regenerative living resources

The E.A.T. App is currently in beta testing and is being prepared for launch on Google Play and Apple iOS platforms.

- Multimedia campaigns promoting sustainability and cultural preservation

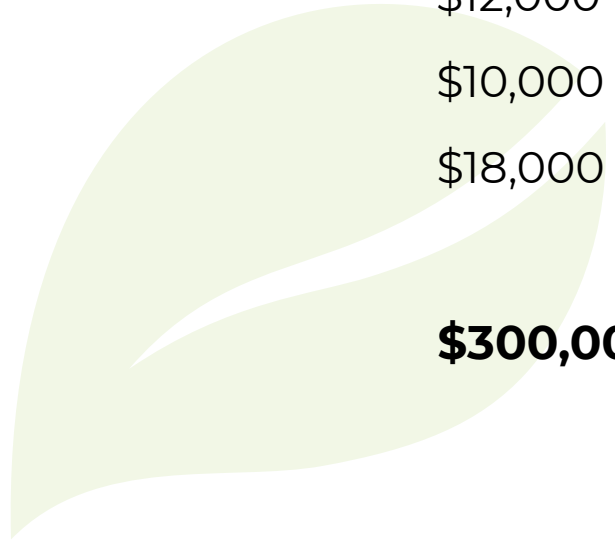
The organization has received community recognition, including a Mayor's Award from the City of East Orange for environmental and youth-focused initiatives.

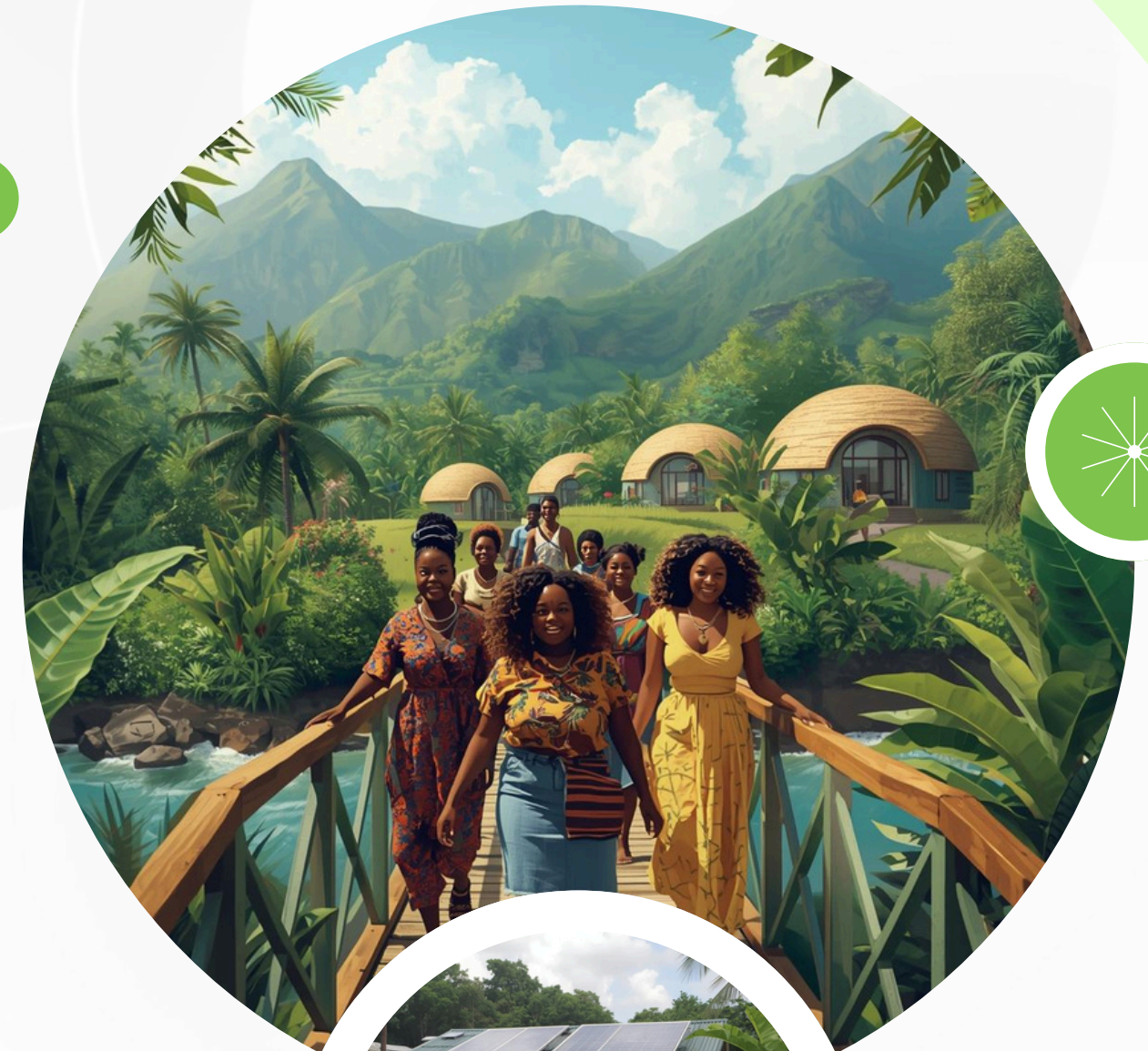

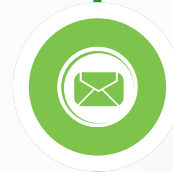
